Environment Check List

A visual scan should be completed from front to back of your service. Start with admission desks, hallway, waiting spaces, washrooms and then clinical spaces. What are the first impressions? Are you promoting safer and inclusive spaces? Include staff spaces in the scan.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Does your service provide inclusive care? If yes, are welcoming symbols (i.e. rainbow) displayed? Where? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Displayed in places visible to patients? • Displayed on staff badges as a sign of Individual competence? 	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Do patient teaching materials reflect sexual and gender diversity? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do health teaching materials have inclusive language and diverse images? • Are there LGBTQ* specific materials where needed?
